Board in Brief: December Highlights

- **Strategic Planning for Success:** During a dedicated Board Retreat on December 15th, the Board and Administration reviewed our district's core beliefs and mission to ensure we are aligned on student success. We are refining our goals to target ranking in the top 50% academically among our ISD peers while maintaining strong financial stewardship with a fund balance of 25% or higher.

- **Investing in Support:** To better serve our students, the Board approved the hiring of a new Secondary Special Education Social Worker, Dominique Keranen, a much-needed addition to help manage student caseloads. Additionally, the Board approved a wage increase for our custodial partners to remain competitive and ensure our facilities are well-maintained.

Come join us for a fun-filled Parent-Game Night!




